You are encouraged to submit a proposal to present research findings at the 2017 meeting of the Southern Risk & Insurance Association (SRIA). Papers on any risk or insurance related topic are welcome. Specific subject areas include, but are not limited to, insurance law or regulation, public policy, economics, finance, health care, international issues, employee benefits, or risk management.

Please submit an executive summary (not exceeding three pages) that describes the purpose, expected results, and importance of the research (completed, full papers may also be submitted). The names and affiliations of all co-authors, with telephone and fax numbers and e-mail address (if available) of the designated contact person, should be provided on a separate cover page attached to the proposal. Also on the cover page, please include 3-5 keywords describing the topic of the submitted research.

Proposals/papers from doctoral students are encouraged. Additionally, doctoral students that have papers accepted for presentation at the meeting will be invited to submit a full paper for the “Best Paper Award.”

The deadline for submission is Monday, August 14, 2017. This deadline will not be extended. Submitting authors will be notified of the outcome of their submissions via email within three weeks of the submission deadline.

Proposals may be submitted via regular mail, fax, or e-mail. However, electronic proposals are preferred and should be submitted as a Word or PDF attachment to:
