The names and affiliations of all co-authors, with telephone, fax numbers, and e-mail address of the designated contact person, should be provided on a separate cover page attached to the proposal. Proposals from doctoral students are encouraged.

The deadline for submission is February 15, 2009. This deadline will not be extended.
